

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a Chartered Quality Institute (CQI) and International Register of Certificated Auditors (IRCA) certificated training course. CQI/IRCA certificated course: 2000-PT 254.

Learners will need to successfully complete Module 1 based on Annex SL in order to audit effectively management systems based on Annex SL.

Learners who successfully complete this course will have completed Module 2 and the CQI/IRCA transition programme that addresses the learning objectives relating to the revised Food Safety Management Systems (FSMS) requirements.

The objective of this course is to provide learners with the knowledge and skills required to perform an audit of part of a food safety management system based on ISO 22000 (or equivalent) and report on the effective implementation and maintenance of the management system in accordance with ISO 19011 and to contribute to the continual improvement of the management system.

- Know and understand the requirements of ISO 22000:2018
- Communicate any changes in FSMS specific requirements arising because of transitioning from ISO 22000:2005 to ISO 22000:2018
